ADMINISTRATION: The Sinclair Town Council meetings are held on the first and third Thursday of each month at 6:00 p.m. To be placed on an agenda, please contact the Town Clerk the Monday prior to the scheduled meeting.

STREETS & PARKS DEPARTMENT: The Town of Sinclair is accepting applications for summer employment. This year we will be hiring two employees for 6 weeks. Applications can be picked up at the Town Office and will be accepted until May 15, 2015. You must be 14 years old to apply.

Reservations are being taken to use our new pavilion in Washington Park. Please call the Town Office at 324-3058. A \$20.00 deposit will be charged for the use of the electric and you will be issued a key to the electrical box.

The deposit will be refunded when the key is returned. If you remove the tables from under the pavilion, please return them. Your cooperation is appreciated.

WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY AND LANDFILL DEPARTMENT: Jim and Chris would like to remind everyone to avoid disposing of household grease and other non-soluble items down the drain as it causes problems in the sewer lines. Please do not flush Clorox wipes, other disinfectant wipes, rags or towels down the toilet; this causes problems in the sewer pumps. The most common foreign object we find in the sewer lines is grease. People do not realize that household grease should not be washed down the drain because eventually it will build up and become hard, causing a blockage. The town will not be liable for sewer back up damages unless there is negligence on the part of the town. We recommend that every resident procure sewer backup coverage under their homeowner's policy.

The Town of Sinclair has a landfill for compost only. This includes grass clippings, leaves, branches and clean wood. No painted wood or wood with nails is allowed. Please dump out your plastic bags and take them with you. The gate to the landfill is kept locked to prevent garbage from being thrown there. If you need access to the landfill, contact Jim or Chris during the weekdays from 7:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. by calling the Town Office at 324-3058. For access in the evenings or on the weekends, please contact the police officer on duty by calling the police Department at 324-4243 and having them dispatched to open the gate for you.

We have noticed people have been dumping their compost outside the landfill gate and along the road to the landfill. Please do not dump your compost outside the landfill.

POLICE DEPARTMENT: Chief Jeff Sanders along with the Recreation Department have scheduled a Bike Rodeo for Friday, May 15, 2015. Meet at Washington Park at 1:00 p.m. with your <u>helmets</u> and your bicycles.

Jeff would like to remind everyone with the warmer weather, to watch out for children playing and riding their bikes.

RECREATION DEPARTMENT: The T-ball/baseball program will begin on May 26, 2015. Please stop by the Recreation Hall and pick up an application for your child to participate. This program is funded by the Sinclair Wyoming Refining Company and the Town of Sinclair.

A basketball tournament for elementary school children will be held in May. Please watch the schedule for the date.
