The Town of Sinclair will host a blood draw on Thursday, February 15, 2018 from 6:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. in the council chambers of the town hall building. When preparing to have your blood drawn remember you must fast accordingly. Fast for 8 to 10 hours and if you are diabetic only fast for 6 to 8 hours. Drink extra water the day before and morning of getting your blood drawn.
