All residents: With the winter season upon us the Town of Sinclair would like to ask the residents to help out with snow removal efforts by moving unattended vehicles and trailers during days of snow events. This way the maintenance department can keep the streets clear of snow, to limit wind rows extending out into the streets making them impassible.

Snow removal will begin at 4 a.m. or 5 a.m. on heavy snow days. This way the streets can be cleared by 7 a.m. This will help people get to work, and buses on the bus routes, so children can get to school on time. Snow will be pushed curb to curb. This will help eliminate the snow drifting into the roadways.

POLICE DEPARTMENT: The police department would like to remind everyone that pet licenses expire on December 31st and need to be renewed each year. Pet licenses can be purchased and renewed at the Town Hall. Proof of rabies vaccination must be provided. The chicken permits will also expire on December 31st and need to be renewed each year.

There are a number of vehicles, trailers, and campers parked on town streets and right of ways that do not have current registrations on them. The town ordinance requires they have current valid registrations to remain in town streets and right of way (the right of way is the area from the sidewalks to the curb and other town owned property adjacent to the street). Please check your registrations to make sure they are current.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: The Sinclair Fire Department and the Town of Sinclair's annual Christmas Delivery will be on Wednesday, December 20th at 6pm. If you would like Santa Claus & his elves to make a special delivery of your Christmas gift to your house then be sure to have your gifts at the Town of Sinclair no later than 3pm on Tuesday, December 19th. Please provide names and addresses for each gift.

The town of Sinclair is currently accepting donations of non-perishable type food & gift cards to help families who might need a boost this Holiday Season. Donations can be dropped off at Town Hall or Rec Hall, please have your donations dropped off no later than 3pm on Tuesday, December 19th. STREETS: Please help with the snow removal, by moving your unattended vehicles and any trailers parked on the street, during days of snow events.

LANDFILL: Landfill is **ONLY** for green waste, such as trees, limbs, branches, leaves, and grass can be disposed of at the landfill. Please do not dispose of general waste at the landfill.

If you need any wood chips for landscaping or gardening, they are available to the residents at the landfill.
